## Practice with TH SH CH

The process I've used with these worksheets is:

1. Review the page of a single sound-pages 2-4 (first do all the THs, look at each picture, determine what the word is, and have your learner say the word to make sure $\mathrm{s} / \mathrm{he}$ can hear the beginning sound)
2. Before you move on to the next sound, go to the next set of worksheets (pages 5-8) and have your learner circle all the words that begin with the sound you've been working on (w/o referring to the corresponding sheet). Depending on how quickly this goes, I sometimes make two copies of this-one for class and one for homework.
3. Repeat both steps with the CH and SH sheets (make lots of copies of $5-8$ and just change the beginning sound on page 5)
4. Move on to pages 9-17. I usually make two copies and do one in class and use one for homework.
